Most claims—for example that the therapy can address neurological, educational, and spatial difficulties—lack supporting evidence. Vision therapy has not been shown to be effective using scientific studies, except for helping with convergence insufficiency. endorsed by orthoptists, ophthalmologists or optometrists. Sunglasses or sun glasses (informally called shades or sunnies; more names below) are a form of protective eyewear designed primarily to prevent bright sunlight and high-energy visible light from damaging or discomforting the eyes. In the early 20th century, they were also known as sun cheaters (cheaters then being an American slang term for glasses). They can sometimes also function as a visual aid, as variously termed spectacles or glasses exist, featuring lenses that are colored, polarized or darkened 23f12df96a

Telescopic sight Similar devices are also found on other platforms such as artillery, tanks and even aircraft. It is equipped with some form of a referencing pattern – known as a reticle – mounted in a focally appropriate position in its optical system to provide an accurate point of aim. Telescopic sights are used with all types of systems that require magnification in addition to reliable visual aiming, as opposed to non-magnifying iron sights, reflector (reflex) sights, holographic sights or laser sights, and are most commonly found on long-barrel firearms, particularly rifles, usually via a scope mount.
