Developmental psychology Developmental psychologists aim to explain how thinking, feeling, and behaviors change throughout life. Originally concerned Developmental psychology is the scientific study of how and why humans grow, change, and adapt across the course of their lives. This field examines change across three major dimensions, which are physical development, cognitive development, and social emotional development. Originally concerned with infants and children, the field has expanded to include adolescence, adult development, aging, and the entire lifespan. Within these three dimensions are a broad range of topics including motor skills, executive functions, moral understanding, language acquisition, social change, personality, emotional development, self-concept, and identity formation. Educational psychology The study of learning processes, from both cognitive and behavioral perspectives, allows researchers to understand individual differences in intelligence, cognitive development, affect, motivation, self-regulation, and self-concept, as well as their role in learning. The field of educational psychology relies heavily on quantitative methods, including testing and measurement, to enhance educational activities related to instructional design, classroom management, and assessment, which serve to facilitate learning processes in various educational settings across the lifespan

Self-esteem is confidence in one's own worth, abilities, or morals. about it (see self). Self-esteem encompasses beliefs about oneself (for example, "I am loved", "I am worthy") as well as emotional states, such as triumph, despair, pride, and shame. Smith and Mackie define it by saying "The self-concept is what we think about the self; self-esteem, is the positive or negative evaluations of the self, as in how we feel about it (see self). ”
