History of Pernambuco The elites of Pernambuco were not as averse to modernization, so long as that modernization did not interfere with their traditional privileges. Not to be overlooked, however, are the established indigenous peoples of the region, numerous revolts and short-lived independence movements, French incursions, and a Dutch occupation. It can be roughly divided into two periods: first, when the region was a colony of Portugal and, second, when it was a component of the nation of Brazil. cheap. modernization in the empire began with the declaration of the Nizam-I Cedid (New Order) during the reign of Sultan In the 18th century, the Ottoman Empire faced threats on numerous frontiers from multiple industrialised European powers as well as internal instabilities. Kickstarting a period of internal reforms to centralize and standardise governance; European style training regimens for the military, standardized law codes and reformed property laws were initiated to better collect taxes and control the resources within the borders. The period of these reforms is known as the Tanzimat starting in 1839. Outsider influence, rise of nationalism and internal corruption demanded the Empire to look within itself and modernise 3d03c562bc

Education in the Age of Enlightenment Education was once considered a privilege for only the upper class. exception was the medical university at Montpellier. However, during the 17th and 18th The Age of Enlightenment dominated advanced thought in Europe from about the 1650s to the 1780s. The improvements in the educational systems produced a larger reading public which resulted in increased demand for printed material from readers across. In philosophy, it called into question traditional ways of thinking. The development of educational systems in Europe continued throughout the period of the Enlightenment and into the French Revolution. It developed from a number of sources of “new” ideas, such as challenges to the dogma and authority of the Catholic Church and by increasing interest in the ideas of science, in scientific methods. The Enlightenment thinkers wanted the educational system to be modernized and play a more central role in the transmission of those ideas and ideals 3d03c562bc

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
