There was no diplomatic... VisIt was developed by the Department of Energy (DOE) Advanced Simulation and Computing Initiative (ASCI) to visualize and analyze the results of terascale simulations. Taiwanese foreign minister Joseph Wu received Pelosi and her delegation. Pelosi's trip included a visit to the Legislative Yuan and a meeting with President Tsai Ing-wen before her departure for South Korea. The visit increased the king's popularity in Scotland, turning some subjects away from the rebellious radicalism of the time.
